

## **Privacy Policy**

### **for data collection according to § 8 of the Ordinance of the State Government on infection-protective measures against the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus (CoronaVO)**

With the following information, we provide you with an overview of the processing of your personal data within the scope of data collection according to § 8 CoronaVO as well as your rights under data protection law.

#### **1. Personal Data**

The data that may be collected in the course of a data collection pursuant to § 8 CoronaVO are personal data. According to Art. 4 No. 1 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), personal data are all data relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.

#### **2. Controller**

#### **3. Data Processing**

Your data will be processed exclusively for the purpose of contact tracking. Upon request and if necessary for tracing possible infection paths, the data will be transferred to the competent authority. No other use will take place. The obligatory data collection is carried out by the person responsible in each case or a person appointed by this person for this purpose. In accordance with the legal requirements, the data are retained for a period of four weeks. After that the data will be deleted. For the duration of the storage, it is ensured that no unauthorised third parties have access to the data.

You are not obliged to provide your data. However, you cannot be granted access without entering your contact data (address and, if available, telephone number) and you must be excluded from visiting or using the facility or participating in the event in accordance with § 8 Paragraph (par.) 2 CoronaVO.

#### 4. Legal Basis

The data processing is based on Article 6 par. 1 (c), par. 2 and 3 GPDR in conjunction with § 32 and §§ 28 to 31 of the Infektionsschutzgesetz (IfSG) as well as § 15 par. 4 and §§ 10, 8 CoronaVO.

#### 5. Your Rights

You have the following rights in relation to the personal data concerning you:

- The right to obtain confirmation as to whether data concerning you are being processed and to receive information on the data processed, further information on the data processing and copies of the data (Article 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectify or complete inaccurate or incomplete data (Article 16 GDPR)
- Right to immediate deletion of data concerning you (Article 17 GDPR)
- Right to restrict processing (Article 18 GDPR)
- Right to object to the future processing of data concerning you, provided that the data are processed in accordance with Article 6(1)(e) or (f) GDPR (Article 21 GDPR)

In addition, you have the right to complain about the processing of your personal data by us with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR). Pursuant to Art. 25 (1) LDSG, the supervisory authority within the meaning of Art. 51 (1) DS-GVO for KIT is:
